



## STEPS TO OBTAINING THE: **PEL LICENSE**

01	Apply to the TEP program first semester of graduate school. You can access the application by clicking <a href="#">here</a> .
02	Complete content requirements. All requirements are offered in our curriculum except “the exceptional child” which is offered as CDS 420 for graduate students. This course would be taken in addition to the courses listed in the current graduate curriculum
03	Pass the Praxis Exam!
04	Pass the ISBE content test for non-teaching SLPS
05	Complete and document the 150 hours on externship. There should be a form for documentation in the externship D2L shell.
06	Apply for Illinois licensure and get temporary license number.
07	Send Dr. Boyer the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• IEIN number, IDFPR number, Dawgtag number</li><li>• Proof of passing the content test</li><li>• Proof that they have the 150 hour requirement</li><li>• Unofficial transcript</li></ul>
